The Beginning of Wisdom

Proverbs 1:7

*The fear of the LORD is
the beginning of knowledge;
fools despise wisdom and instruction.*

Step 1

Read Proverbs 1:7 slowly. Consider what “the fear of the LORD” means in your daily life—not in theory, but in practice.

Step 2

Reflect briefly:

- Where might God be inviting you to greater humility, trust, or obedience?
- Where might you be resisting His wisdom or instruction?

Step 3

Write a short prayer responding to what you see.

Step 4

Offer the prayer to the Lord and take the card home with you.

The fear of the LORD is not fear of punishment, but reverent awe that leads to obedience and trust. **All wisdom in Proverbs flows from this foundation.**
